Henry Brockman of Missouri served in the Confederate Army during the Civil War. During his time in the military he described his daily activities, the places he visited, and the things he saw. As Brockman "traveled through fine country," his tour of duty took him to major battles in Arkansas and Louisiana, including stops at Jacksonport, Pocahontas, Yellville, Des Arc, Helena, Little Rock, Benton, Arkadelphia, Warren, Camden, and Shreveport. For over 100 years, the Arkansas History Commission (State Archives) has preserved Brockman's writings.
